- 1. Increase curb appeal
 - a. Consider style of door

 - a. A well-insulated door will keep your garage warmer in the winter and cooler in summer.
 - b. Insulating factors Polystyrene vs Polyurethane (offers higher R-value)
- 3. Safety and Security
 - a. Up-to-date opener technology provides security to your home
 - b. Doors with photoelectric sensors makes your house a safer place
- 4. Door material types: wood, composite wood, aluminum, or steel? (Wood doors look fantastic when they are new but need to be recoated every few years.) The other door options can give you a wood look for a fraction of the cost of real wood.
- 5. Door color (other than wood option)
 - a. Pick from what door manufacturer offers
 - b. Custom painted by professional painter
- 6. Windows/no windows besides adding style, windows can supply much needed light to the garage interior. Match the glass style to houses windows if possible.
- 7. Cost what fits your budget
 - a. Compare cost vs value
